

Q: What can go into Commingled Containers?

A: All glass, aluminum, tin, bi-metals, jars & jugs primarily consisting of containers identified by HDPE and PET, plastics #1 - #7, as well as the bags in which those containers are collected. An accumulation of plastic bags is not permitted. Please recycle these in bins at your grocery store.

Q: What can go into Commingled Fiber bins?

A: Products which include newsprint, periodicals, cardboard, "junk mail", books plus inserts delivered in subscription and promotional newspapers. Hopefully, you will recycle books by donating them to a library or a friend.

Q: Are Styrofoam containers recyclable?

A: No. Although some Styrofoam food containers display the recycle symbol, all Styrofoam units must still go to landfills.
